

How to plant pot roses

Planting period: May-September

The Expert for your roses.

- Pot roses can be planted all year round in frost-free periods.
- Avoid planting during midday heat.
- Just check if the root bale is well rooted (white roots are visible on the bottom side)
- Just check if the soil is humid, otherwise water the bale.
- Dig a hole in a sunny place, wide and deep enough to accept the roots of the plant.
- Do not add fertilizer in the plant hole!
- The addition of horn shavings or well-cured garden compost to the garden soil before planting will help ensure a strong growth. Alternatively you may use special rose substrate.
- Remove the pot and put the rose plant into the prepared plant hole.
- The grafting point should be around 5 cm below ground level.
- Afterwards fill plant hole with soil, compress carefully and water well. Keep the soil humid during the next week.
